Could use a more human feel to build trust				
Why Sprouts section - too wordy				
YouTube videos on parent tools is the most important				
Drawn to the Shop first				
Wouldn't have read everything if it wasn't recommended (about page)				
(This was before we changed the Home page)Not enough info on Home page about what's in a lesson				
Would never look for a podcast from a browser				
Didn't know the parent YouTube was for parent tips				
People don't read blogs often				
Thought "Things we love" was for other blogs and resources by other parents				
When asked to sign up and pay for the program went to Shop first				
Started free version through the "start shining for free" CTA				
Wanted a link from the thank you for subscribing email to go to the dashboard				
Wanted more detail about kids progress on the parent dashboard (what they watched, learned, passed etc)				
Wanted a report of some sort when click on videos watched and badges earned				
Gamification would be cool, like a leaderboard of all kids				
Wanted a help me now button that could be accessed from anywhere - lead to solution videos or resources				
Would like an easy way to find facebook live archives				
Didn't notice the filter button on the dashboard to filter by life skills				
Said they would watch the video with their kid				
Mentioned downloading the pdf first				
Would like to see the supplies right away on the screen so he would know if he has the right supplies and can do the activity				
If he trusted the site he would let his kid work alone				
Thinks he can trust this but might like to see something that says the video is secure (powered by vimeo)				
Would like an app, browser product is harder for a kid to use				
Scripture reference in About should be more noticeable				
Wouldn't want to see pop-up ads

Start Paid subscription - go through the start shining for free CTA				
Start Free subscription - the graphic that talks about both subscriptions				
To submit a coaching question - went to parent tools first				
Tried to sign-in to dashboard under Parent Tools first				
What's the difference between star chart and badges				
Is afraid kids would submit a question through the video screen (submit question button)				
Didn't understand that they could scroll down on the home page
